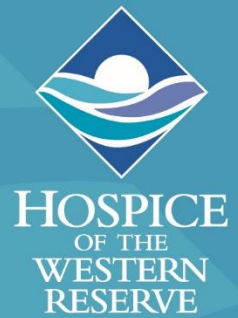


# Enhance Your Patient Visits with Music
