- Register no later than **one week** in advance of group start date

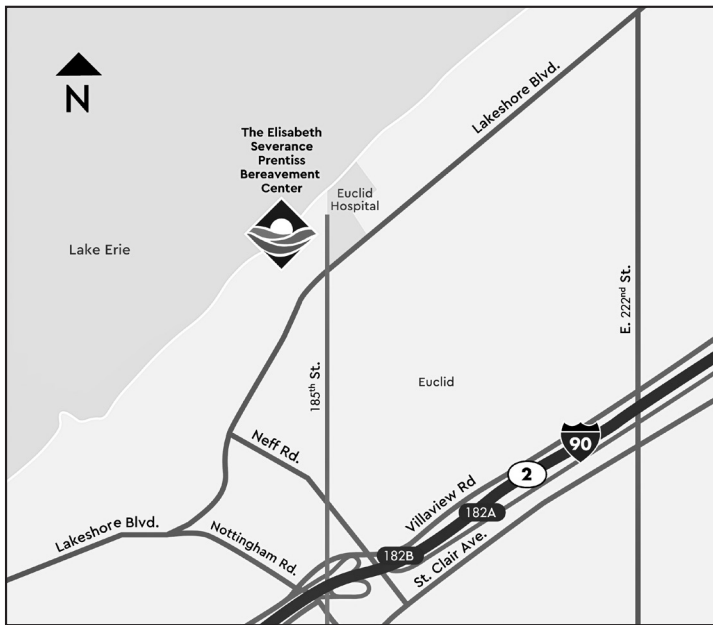
