- **In person workshops are subject to change.** Please contact Mollie Borgione for workshop status

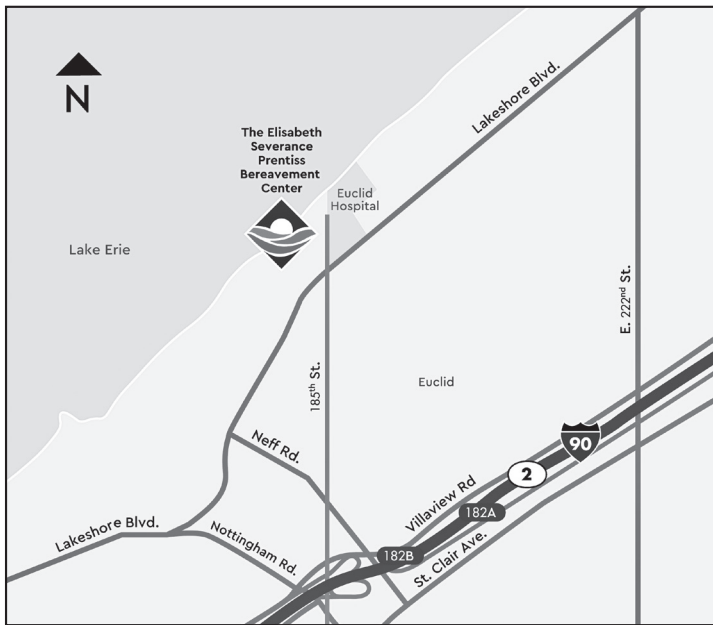
