

IPU Visitation Policy

This visitation policy has been established to protect our patients, staff, and visitors. This policy is in effect regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status. **This policy is subject to change at any time based on factors such as, but not limited to, COVID-19 community spread, incidence and infection rates.**

General

- Visitors are permitted to visit 24/7. Upon entrance into the building, we ask that you please provide the patient's name to gain admittance. Please sign in upon arrival.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult throughout their-visit.
- Visitors must use hand sanitizer prior to proceeding to the patient's room and each time they enter and exit the patient's room.
- Pet visitation is permitted. The facility's pet policy must be always followed.
- Visitors may not enter or exit through patient room doors or any other exterior door. They must enter and exit through the main entrance only.
- Patients whose visitors do not comply with this policy will not be permitted further in-person visitation. If necessary, security will be called to enforce this policy and/or remove visitors from the facility.

Masking

- Visitors for patients without a COVID-19 diagnosis or symptoms, masking is Optional.
- Visitors for patients with COVID-19 or suspected of having COVID-19 do so at their own risk, a KN95 mask will be provided. KN95 masks must be worn for the duration of time visitors are outside the patient room, visitors are strongly encouraged to mask while in the patient room as well. Access to public restrooms (if patient restroom can' t be used), vending machines and coffee machine is permitted.
